Restate in your own words the thought and meaning of the following passages. Be sure to preserve the tone of the original and avoid plagiarism.

1. Prescriptivists, who spend most of their time worrying about 'correctness', teach that regional dialects are inferior to Standard English. This is largely because standards of correctness in our society are set by the written language, and most important writing uses Standard English vocabulary and grammar. Even prescriptivists, however, if pushed, would have to admit that regional dialects add pungency and force to the language, and that the world would be blander and less interesting without them.
2. Mr. Gile Radice declared, 'We are losing 1,000 scientists a year to the brain drain. Higher education in this country is seriously under-funded and in need of increased resources both for teaching and research.'

IV. Summary and critique 40%

Read the passage below and summarize the passage in no more than 50 words. Then write a critique of the following passage.

Decisions relating to the organization of course content, the presentation of new topics, and their sequence and scope of treatment, all depend on the underlying educational and linguistic assumptions as well as on our concurrent understanding of the learning process. Linguistic approaches usually view language as made up of discrete units such as words, sentences, patterns or functions. The discrete unit fits well with a carefully planned series of steps. Learners are expected to master the particular unit of work before they continue to the next one since even the process, according to this approach, is viewed as consisting of distinct points of mastery along the continuum. Moreover, some learning theories advocate a sequence which progresses from simple to complex forms, while others begin with the most frequently used forms and advance to less frequent ones. At times the decisive factor is the functional load of the form, or its usefulness in real-life situations and contexts. According to this view, learners should encounter the more common forms earlier so as to ensure effective learning.
