The KLRI held 23rd Anniversary International Academic Conference under the theme "Creative Economy through Smart Regulation for Startups and Technological Innovation." The conference provide an opportunity to interpret creative economy from a legal and policy perspective. Additionally, the conference unveiled a set of measures for the development of a creative economy

by supporting venture start-ups.

Under presentation entitled "Providing Second Chance for Entrepreneurs", the KLRI Researcher Han Jung Mi emphasized an importance of adopting speedy process of the workout program.
